What personal data we collect and why we collect it

Information we may collect

Information you give us. You may give us information about you by filling in forms on our site, using social media logins and/or other plugins, or by corresponding with us by phone, email or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you register to use our site, subscribe to a newsletter or service, order products or services, upload content, and/or participate in discussion boards or other social media functions on our site. The information you give us may include (but is not necessarily limited to):

- your personal name and address;
- your email address;
- your phone number;
- your photograph

We use the information you provide about yourself to complete your request or to provide you with the products and services you requested. We do not share this information with third parties except to the extent necessary to complete the process or subsequent order you may make where we will use your information to carry out our obligations. We may notify you about changes or to make suggestions and recommendations that may interest you about our range of products or services, or to ensure that content from us is presented and delivered in the most effective manner.

Cookies

A cookie is a small text file written to your hard drive that contains information about your account and use of this site. Cookies do not contain any personal information about users. Cookies enable us to collect useful information and to improve your experience when accessing and using our site.

When you log in, we will also set up several cookies to save your login information and your screen display choices. Login cookies last for two days, and screen options

cookies last for a year. If you select “Remember Me”, your login will persist for two weeks. If you log out of your account, the login cookies will be removed.

Embedded content from other websites

Articles on this site may include embedded content (e.g. videos, images, articles, etc.). Embedded content from other websites behaves in the exact same way as if the visitor has visited the other website.

- This service runs in the background and drops one or more cookies to your computer, or handheld device.
